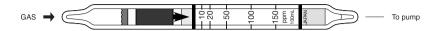
P-DICHLOROBENZENE



1. PERFORMANCE

1) Measuring range 10-150 ppmNumber of pump strokes $1 (100 \text{m} \ell)$

2) Sampling time : 1.5 minutes/1 pump stroke

3) Detectable limit : 6 ppm

4) Shelf life : 1 year (Necessary to store in refrigerated conditions; $0 \sim 10^{\circ}$ C)

5) Operating temperature : $0 \sim 40 \,^{\circ}\text{C}$

6) Temperature compensation : Necessary (See "TEMPERATURE CORRECTION TABLE")
7) Reading : Direct reading from the scale calibrated by 1 pump stroke

8) Colour change : White→Blueish purple

2. RELATIVE STANDARD DEVIATION

RSD-low : 15 % RSD-mid. : 10 % RSD-high : 10 %

3. CHEMICAL REACTION

By reacting with an Oxidizer, Hydrogen chloride is produced and PH indicator is discoloured. C₆H₄CI₂ + PbO₂ + H₂SO₄ → HCI
